3. *Francois Courcloni, French Canadian* was my father ; and *Francois Beauchamp, half-breed*, is my mother

4. I have not made or caused to be made any claim of land or Scrip other than the above in this or any other Parish in said Province, nor have I claimed or received, as an Indian, any annuity moneys, from the Government of said Dominion.
